Data Protection Policy

This policy explains about the collection of personal data by Deudraeth Camera Club.

Deudraeth Camera Club (also referred to in this document as DCC) was established to further the objects set out in its constitution, serving the interests of members and the wider community, and is a data controller within the UK.

The personal information referred to in this Policy may include full name, distinctions, contact details, affiliations, service records, records of entries to events, and such other information as may be necessary for the effective management of the legitimate interests of Deudraeth Camera Club. Any person wishing to verify the information held by DCC, or who can correct or update that information, may apply to the Secretary.

This information may only be collectively shared with other members.

Photographers, as creators of images, allow DCC to share their information with other groups involved in DCC competitions and awards, which may be published in their resultant catalogues, articles and results, subject to the rules of the DCC constitution.

DCC will hold your personal data for as long as you are a member but may retain historical archives indefinitely, for example but not limited to, records of meetings, handbooks, catalogues, awards and other event results, fully complying with our legal obligations.

DCC will securely destroy any details no longer relevant.

General business records will be held for a minimum of six years.

DCC reserves the right to amend this data policy without prior notice, but such changes will be published on our website - www.deudraethcameraclub.co.uk
